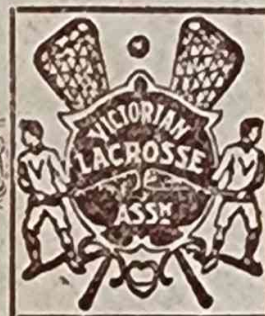

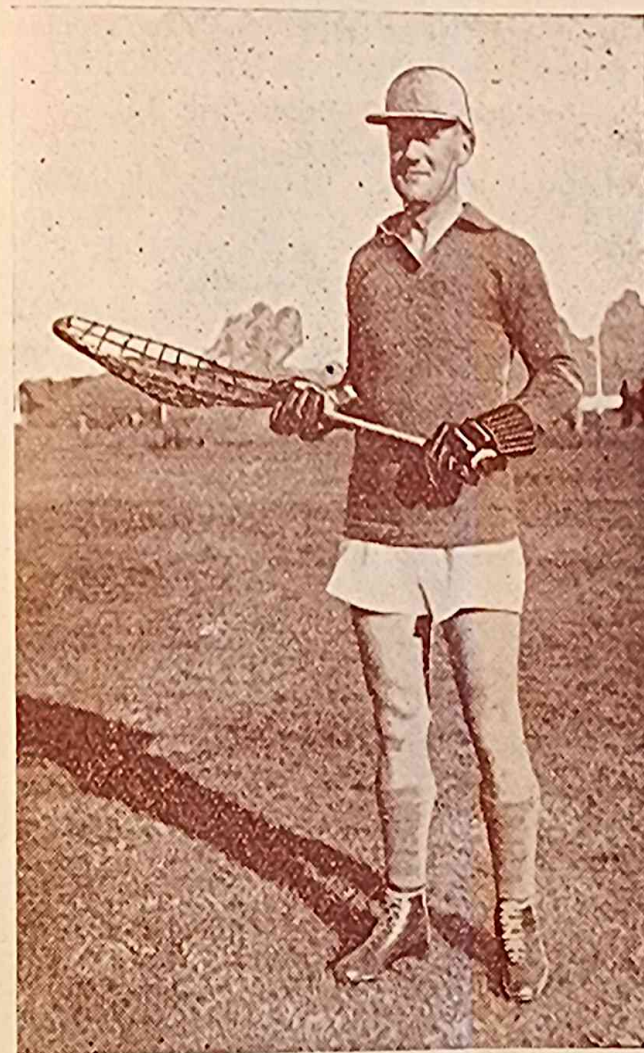

### THERE ARE GOLDEN RULES IN LACROSSE, AS IN ALL GAMES—

#### THESE ARE SOME OF THEM

(By JOHN L. BEATTIE, Former Victorian Captain)

1. Good Stick work is most essential and can be best  
achieved by 10 minutes Brick Wall Practise each day  
during the season.

2. Always have two hands on your Stick when pick-  
ing up, catching, and throwing the ball.

3. Every young player should be conversant with the  
rules of the game. Many make mistakes through not  
knowing the rules. With the study of the rules comes  
also the knowledge of the values of each position on  
the field.

4. If you are a forward you must always be on the  
alert. Making position is all important, but above all  
keep the front of the goals open. If a back player,  
stick to your man very closely, try and learn how to  
body check. It is so seldom done today. If a centre  
or an attack player, when your side is attacking, you  
should become a forward, provided your stick work  
is good enough. I do not mean by this you should  
wander down forward and crowd the goals. You should  
lose your placed man and be in the position to play  
the ball on or make the odd man. When the other side  
is attacking, you should make sure you are in position  
to relieve the ball from the defence lines.

5. Do not run too much. Remember a ball can be  
thrown much faster than a player can run and throwing  
does not get you out of position—running often does.

6. Keep your eye on the ball. Know where your own  
men and your opponents are, both in front and behind  
you, know where the goal is. In other words study  
position, know which opponent is dangerous and likely  
to score.



7. Always think a move or two ahead. Keep saying to yourself: "If I get the ball, what is the best thing to do with it?" Don't think after the ball is passed to you what is best to be done. When you get it, act at once with speed and determination.

8. As a rule, a successful team has only one Captain, and he is the mouth-piece of the side. Loyalty is what he wants from his team. If he has this, a team can go far and make up for defects in play to a big extent.

9. A player should remember that loyalty to his club counts for a lot more than selfishness. Lacrosse Matches are won by sacrifice. If you are beaten, be beaten as a team, with every man pulling his weight to the finish.

10. Never under-rate your opponents. Much better that you over-rate them.

11. Do not argue with the umpire and take no notice of what is said from outside the arena.

12. Keep your head, keep your feet, and above all, keep your temper.

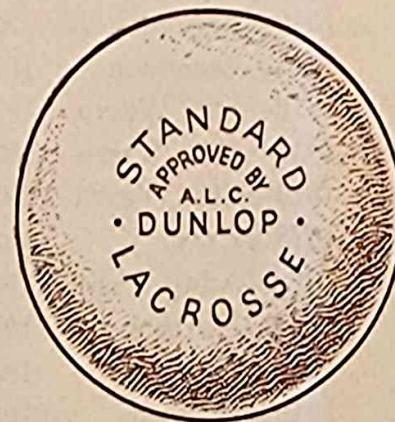

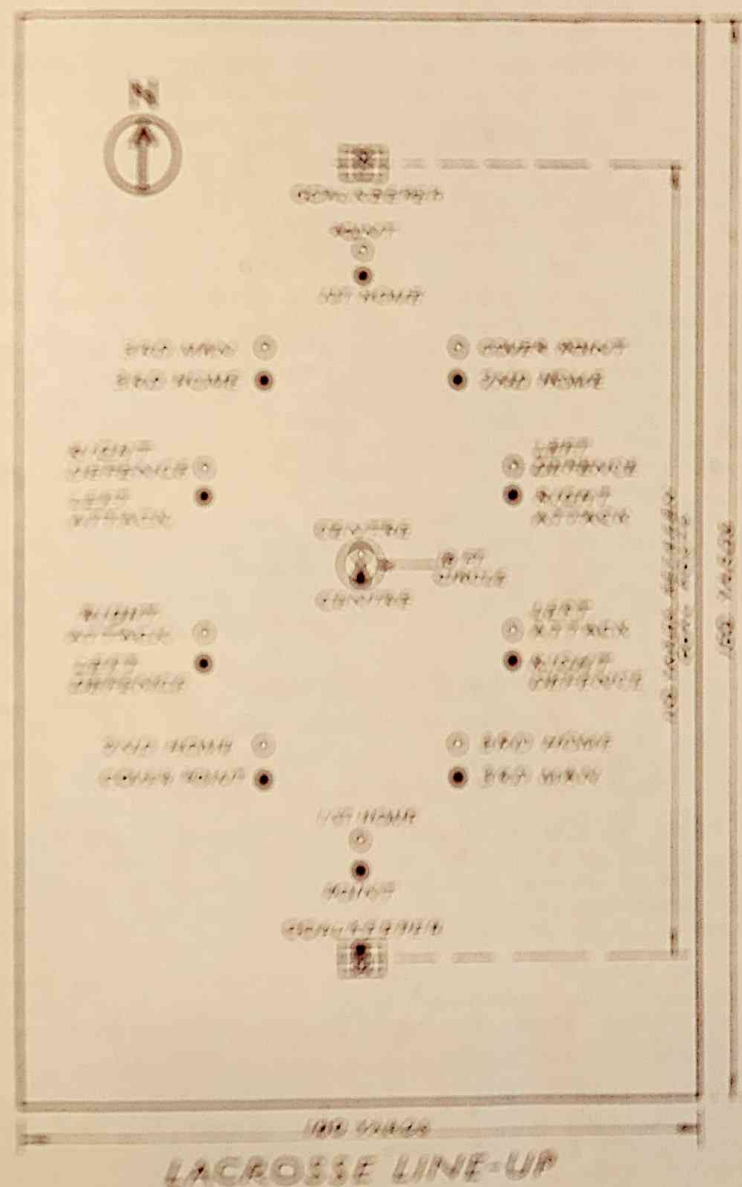

# Some Rules Relating to Permits

## POWER TO MAKE REGULATIONS

- 26A. (a) The Committee may at any time at its discretion make regulations (provided they are not inconsistent with the Constitution and Rules) relating to any or all of the following matters, namely:
- (i) the granting of permits to players.
  - \* (b) Regulations shall be deemed to have been made and shall be operative if approved by a resolution of a majority of members present at a meeting of the Committee of which notice specifying that a motion to approve regulations will be moved has been given to the members.
  - (c) Regulations made in accordance with the preceding clause may be repealed or amended from time to time on a resolution of a majority of the members present at a meeting of the Committee of which notice specifying that a motion to repeal or amend (as the case may be) will be moved has been given to the members.
  - (d) Regulations relating to the granting of permits if and when made shall be binding on the Permit Committee in considering any application for a permit and upon the Independent Investigation Committee in considering any appeal from a decision of the Permit Committee.

## PERMIT REGULATIONS

(In Force on 1st July, 1937.)

1. Under no circumstances will a permit be granted to a player from a Club with which he is unfinancial.

2. Subject to Rule 35 a permit will be granted to any player from a Club to play with an Institutional Club even if the application is opposed, provided the player submits a certificate by a responsible officer of the Institution that such player is a member of the Institution.

For the purpose of this Regulation, the following Clubs shall be deemed to be Institutional Clubs, viz.: Adult Deaf, Army, Legacy, Power House, St. Kilda Road Deaf Boys, Melbourne Cricket Club.

Provided, however, that an application by one member of an Institutional Club to play with another Institutional Club, if opposed by the first Club, may be dealt with as the Permit Committee thinks fit.

3. A player who has been granted a permit to play with an Institutional Club shall not be granted a permit to any Club other than that to which he belonged when the permit to the Institutional Club was granted if the Club to which he belonged at the time the permit to the Institutional Club was granted opposes the application.

4. Subject to Rule 35 a permit will be granted to any player to play with either the University Club or the Teachers' College Club if such player is a student at the University or Teachers' College as the case may be, even if the application is opposed. Regulation 3 shall apply to players of the Teachers' College Club as if such Club were an Institutional Club.

5. Subject to Rule 35, a player who has been granted a permit to play with the University under Regulation 4 will not after leaving the University be granted a permit to any Club other than that to which he belonged when the permit to the University was granted if such Club opposes the application unless such Club has no team in the same section as or in a higher section or one section lower than that in which the University team with which the player regularly played is graded.

6. A permit will not be granted to a player who learned the game with a school team to play with any Club other than an Old Boys' Club associated with such school (if any) if such Old Boys' Club (if any) opposes the application, unless the player has previously been granted a permit since leaving school to play with another Club.

7. On joining a school where lacrosse is played, a pupil who has formerly played with or been registered as a member of another Club will (even though the application is opposed by such Club) be given a permit to play with the school team in V.I.A. Saturday matches provided a permit is requested within six months of the boy commencing school. For purposes of this Regulation, "School team" means a team consisting wholly of pupils of the school and does not include a team which consists wholly or partly of Old Boys of the school. Each Old Boys' Club shall at the commencement of each season nominate the team or teams of its Club which shall be school teams. The Permit Committee may make it a condition of granting such a Permit that it shall cease to operate if the player is not picked to play in 50 per cent. of the games played by the school team after the granting of the permit.

8. A player who has been given a permit under Regulation 7 will, on making application after leaving school, be granted a permit back to the Club with which he was a player or registered member immediately prior to the granting of the permit to the school team, even though such application is opposed by the school Old Boys' Club.



9. These Regulations other than Regulation 1 shall not apply to an application by a player for a permit to play with the Melbourne Cricket Club Lacrosse Club. Such an application shall be dealt with by the Permit Committee as it thinks fit.

10. Except where Regulation 1 applies, a permit will be granted to any player to play with a team of a Club in a higher section even if imposed by his Club if his Club fails to pick him to play for three consecutive games in a season in the same or a higher section than that to which he desires a permit.

The Permit Committee may make it a condition of such permit that if the new Club fails to pick the player in at least 50 per cent. of games played by the team to which a permit was granted during the season in which the permit is granted, the permit shall cease to operate.

11. A permit to play in a particular first or grand first matches will only be granted to a player who has played in his team six consecutive matches in the same or a lower section during the current season up to the date of application if he has not played in a higher section during the six Saturdays immediately preceding the date of the first scheduled match, and if he has been prevented during such said six Saturdays from playing in the section for which permission to play is desired on a lower section by reason of illness, injury, absence from Melbourne or similar reason.

12. In the case of all other applications, whether approved or not, the Permit Committee may in its discretion refuse or grant a permit with or without conditions or may state none as it thinks fit.

13. No permit between Clubs shall be granted in any season after the first day of July in that season. This Regulation shall only apply to applications by players who have played at least one match with an affiliated Club during the current season.

14. In the event of there being a conflict between any of these Regulations in their application to a particular player, the Permit Committee shall decide whether a permit shall be granted or not.

#### PERMIT COMMITTEE

15. The Committee shall at its first meeting in each year elect from its members a Permit Committee of five members and the Hon. Secretary and Assistant Hon. Secretary, who shall be ex-officio members without voting power (these members with voting power to form a quorum).

The Permit Committee shall have the following powers, viz. —

(a.) subject to the rules and any regulations relating thereto to decide on all matters relating to permits to players and to grant or refuse any application for a permit subject or not to conditions as the Committee thinks fit, and if it so desires to defer consideration of any such application;

(b.) to impose such fines for breaches of the rules as the rules and regulations empower the Committee to impose;

(c.) to deal with all reports of matches other than reports of protests which by the rules must be dealt with by the Independent Investigation Committee, and to take such action in connection therewith as the Committee thinks fit;

(d.) to approve of the change of the ground of any team and subject to the rules and regulations to deal with any other matters relating to the playing of matches;

(e.) to appoint referees, goal umpires, boundary umpires and/or timekeepers to such matches under the control of the Association as the Permit Committee thinks fit, provided that the failure of the Permit Committee to appoint goal umpires and/or a timekeeper shall not relieve any Club from its liability under the rules as to do;

(f.) to deal with any complaint by a Club as to the efficiency or conduct of a referee which does not amount to a report such as is required by the rules to be dealt with by the Independent Investigation Committee;

(g.) to suspend or disqualify any referee in its sole discretion;

(h.) to take such action as it thinks fit to suspend referees in the current interpretation of the Laws of Lacrosse and subject to any interpretation adopted by the General Committee to direct the interpretation to be placed on any law of Lacrosse by the referee and subject to such law as direct the penalty to be imposed by the referee for breach thereof; and

(i.) to revoke at any time any permit granted by it as in Article 18.

(See also Permit Regulations 12 and 13.)

#### JUNIOR PERMIT COMMITTEE

16. (a.)

(b.)

(c.) The Junior Committee may at its first meeting in each year appoint a Junior Permit Committee of five members which shall have powers subject to the rules:

(d.) to grant, refuse or revoke permits in respect of players in the Junior Division provided that apply



actions in person in the A, B or C sections to play in the Junior Division shall be subject also to the prior approval of the Football Committee.

- (b) to control the appointment of referees to all Junior Division games provided that the Football Committee shall have final choice of all referees, etc.
- (c) to exercise all powers of the Football Committee to impose fines for breaches of rules in respect of any team or Club in the Junior Division;
- (d) to exercise such other powers as may be allowed to it by the Committee of Management from time to time;
- (e) to appoint two of its members to collaborate with the officers occupying offices in respect of games in the Junior Division.

30. \*So long as the Junior Football Committee is in operation pursuant to Rule 20A it shall continue the powers of the Football Committee which cease to operate in respect of the section within the control of such Junior Football Committee pursuant to such rule.

#### PLAYERS

##### (a) Inter-Club

31. No person who is or has been a member of any Club in Victoria, whether constituted or not, or of any Club under Association outside Victoria, shall be allowed to take part in any matches under the control of the Victorian Football Association unless he shall have first made application to the Football Committee in the Form B in Schedule 3 hereto, and shall also have produced to such Committee a certificate in the Form C in the said schedule from the Committee of the last-mentioned Club, or of the said Club under Association outside Victoria as the case may be. Provided always that the Football Committee shall have power in its discretion to refuse to admit for any period any such application.

32. All players shall be bound for the season to the Club they first play with in that season, and shall not play with any other without the express consent of the Football Committee.

33. There shall be no interchanges of players between teams from the same Club engaged in the same section except with the consent of the Football Committee.

(See also Football Regulations 3, 24, 26, 28.)

##### (b) Inter-Section

34. No player who has played three matches in any section for a period of three years prior to the commencement of the

current season shall be allowed to play in any section Junior Division unless with the sanction of the Football Committee. Provided always that the Football Committee shall not in any one season grant a permit to more than two members of any one Club who have in that or the previous season played three matches in a higher section or a section two grades or more lower than such higher section according only to such sections in which such Club is engaged, and provided that such two members shall not receive permits for the same team. Provided, however, that notwithstanding anything in this section contained in the award of the Executive Committee in pursuance of its powers under Rule 20 heretofore depending on teams from a higher to a lower section, then it shall not be necessary for any player of such designated team who has played more than three matches in the higher section during the previous year with such designated team to obtain a permit to play with such designated team in the lower section. Provided that when a permit to play in a lower section in any season has been granted, it shall remain in force until a player has played three matches in a higher section in that season or ensuing seasons; after having played such three matches, the player shall not again play in such lower section without a further permit, and when a second permit has been granted to the player in one season, he must obtain a further permit after every match played in a higher section in that season.

(See also Football Regulations 3, 4 and 5.)

##### (c) Semi-Finals, Finals and Grand Finals

35. (a) No player shall participate in semi-final, final or grand final matches unless he is a properly registered player and has played in not less than six preliminary matches in the same or a lower section during the current season before such semi-final, final or grand final matches are played, unless with the permission of the Football Committee.

(b) Any registered player who has not played six games as aforesaid through absence from Melbourne, injury, illness or other genuine reason may apply to the Football Committee for permission to play in semi-final, final and/or grand final matches and the Football Committee may grant such permission if it thinks fit.

(See also Football Regulation 25.)

(Applications for inter-section and inter-club permits should be made on forms obtainable from the Hon. Secretary of the Association.

All applications for permits must be lodged with the Honorary Secretary of the Association not later than 4 o'clock p.m. on the Tuesday in each week to ensure consideration at that week's meeting of the Football Committee.



## APPEALS

30. "In the event of an application being refused, the Chairman of the Board Committee shall call on the Parent Committee's members for such action on the application, and the same shall be submitted to the Investigation Committee in the event of an appeal. Every appeal so made shall be in writing, together with the grounds of such appeal, and the appeal is subject to the decision of the Board Committee, and no appeal shall be entertained on the ground of an appeal being made. Such appeal shall be accompanied by an amount of 50/-, which shall be forfeited if the appeal is refused. Refused.

## SUBSTITUTES

31. "No player shall play with any Club in one season for more than two matches as a substitute without being qualified to do so by parent. In the event of a substitute being played his name and club, if any, must be recorded on the report card. Subject to this rule, no player shall play as a substitute without the approval of the Captain of the opposing side.
